Pearson TQ Level 3 Intermediate Apprenticeship in Logistic Operations

Course Aim

The Pearson Edexcel Level 3 Certificate in Logistics Operations aims to provide a suitable qualification that will allow individuals to demonstrate their competence and understanding against a clear set of standards based on the needs of the industry. This qualification has been designed to support those involved with distributive operations such as dealing with the handling and storing of goods within a commercial, industrial or removers' warehouses, or freight facility, movement of goods, customer service and stock control.

Entry Eligibility

Logistic Specialist (Supply) with the rank of LCpl. An apprenticeship is only suitable to those requiring new skills, knowledge or behaviours in this area so enrolment needs to take place prior to completion of leadership training, for example CLM part 3.

Duration

Minimum of 12 months.

Cost and Payment

Course costs are covered by Government funding (ESFA) therefore free for the Learner.

Method of Delivery

Delivery is a combination of direct contact (F2F) and remote support via phone/email/Skype etc.

Modules

Modules are based on the Logistic Specialist (Supply) role. Typically, there are 7 units to complete (3 mandatory and 4 optional) ranging from health and safety, optimise the use of logistic resources, supervise the receipt, storage or dispatch and schedule logistic operations. English and Maths functional skills at level 2 also required if not already obtained.

Assessment

Assessments will be completed in the work place, at a Pearson TQ Learning Resource Centre (LRC) or remotely via phone/Skype etc. Knowledge requires the Learner to identify, describe and explain in detail either by writing, typing or verbal (best and most efficient way) and the performance requires the production of evidence that the criteria/standard is achieved. Assessment methods used include observation, Q&A, formal testing, witness testimonies and work-based discussions.

Tutor Support

All learners will be allocated a Training Officer (TO) who will provide full support to the learner as required and additional support for Functional Skills (FS) is given by a specialist.

Equipment Required

No equipment is formally required to complete the apprenticeship unless remote assessment/support is needed. At each LRC there are computers available if learners would like to produce typed work.

Enrolment Process
