

Postal and Courier Operator – The Royal Logistic Corps

Class 1 Course Reg & Res

Course Aim.

To train and develop Class 2 Postal and Courier Operators technical and supervisory skills to meet the requirements of a Class 1 soldier as defined by relevant policy.

Course Objectives.

Training Objectives associated with the Class 1 course are:

- Manage Postal and Courier Operations Cell
- Conduct procedures relating the movement of Protectively Marked material (PMM) in accordance with current policy.
- Manage Sorting Office Duties.
- Conduct General FPO Management Duties.
- Conduct additional Postal and Courier Services Tasks.

Duration.

The course is three weeks residential training for regular soldiers and 15 days consecutive for reservists, delivered at the Postal and Courier Division at Worthy Down.

Enrolment Criteria.

Personnel must meet the following criteria to apply for the course¹:

- A minimum of 18 months employment experience as an RLC Postal and Courier Operator Class 2.
- Selected LCpl.

Accreditation.

The course is accredited and mapped to professional qualifications at Level 4 Management of Postal and Courier Services.

Dates & Enrolment.

Course dates for each Training Year can be found within the relevant DCLPA Pamphlets. Queries and applications are to be submitted via the Unit career management single point of contact to the courses clerk within DCLPA Training Operations.
