

# **Chef – The Royal Logistic Corps Class 2 Upgrade**

## **Aim.**

To continue the development of Class 3 Chefs' post Initial Trade Training (ITT).

## **Objectives.**

The aim of the Class 2 upgrade process is to allow a Chef Class 3 to develop their skills and demonstrate competence to the required standard (found in 3-2 upgrade paperwork). Competency must be achieved in both craft and deployable skills. Class 2 status is one of the requirements for eligibility for promotion to LCpl.

## **Duration and content.**

The Class 2 upgrade is achieved through successful completion of the level 2 Production Chef apprenticeship (or equivalent DIN 2019DIN07-058 refers) and practical demonstration of field catering skills. CoC are responsible for completing 3-2 upgrade paperwork, once complete it is then actioned by FSTW, then finally, unit HR make the required changes to JPA.

## **Enrolment Criteria.**

Personnel must meet the following criteria to apply for the course<sup>1</sup>:

- Be a qualified Chef Class 3.
- Must have completed Lv 2 Production chef apprenticeship.

## **Accreditation.**

## **Dates & Enrolment.**

Timings for the completion of 3-2 varies dependant on skill levels of apprentices, that said there is a minimum requirement for apprentices to complete their apprenticeship prior to being eligible for 3-2 upgrade. 3-2 upgrade applications are to be submitted the CPD centre to carry out the required actions. Any queries in relation to 3-2 upgrades are to be directed to the AWO.
