

## **ARMY CHEF – LEVEL 3 SENIOR PRODUCTION CHEF APPRENTICESHIP**

### **Course Aim**

The Level 3 Senior Production Chef Apprenticeship aims to provide a qualification that enables individuals to progress through their Army Chef Career. The Apprenticeship includes a Level 3 qualification, The individual will demonstrate their Knowledge, Skills and behaviours against a set of standards devised by the catering industry as a whole. The qualification has been designed to support those involved in the Army Chef trade, to assist them in their development and progression within their job role.

### **Entry Eligibility – Chef Class 1**

### **Duration**

Minimum of 15 months.

### **Cost and Payment**

Course costs are covered by Government funding (ESFA) therefore free for the Learner.

### **Method of Delivery**

The Army Apprenticeship blends the training delivered during the Chef Class 1 course, with practical work and a portfolio which is completed in the Learner's Field Army Unit. Delivery is a combination of face-to-face, online learning and mentoring in the Field Army.

### **Modules**

Work is based on the Level 3 Senior Production chef standards. There are 6 areas to complete, including, Legal and governance, People, Business and Commercial, Personal development and performance, Kitchen Operations, and Nutrition.

### **End Point Assessment**

The End Point Assessment (EPA) will be completed in the workplace, by the End Point Assessment Organisation (EPAO), The EPAO for the Army Chef CEG apprenticeship is the Army Catering Training Trust. The EPA consists of a Multi Choice Question Paper (MCQP), Professional Discussion (PD) and an Observation (O).

### **Mentor Support**

All learners will be allocated a Training mentor at Unit who will provide full support to the learner as they progress through their apprenticeship, this will be fully supported by the unit CoC (RCWO/UCM).

### **Equipment Required**

No equipment is formally required to complete the apprenticeship unless remote assessment/support is needed. If equipment is required to carry out EPA this will be provide by the EPAO or CoC as required.

### **Enrolment Process**

Conducted during the CC1 course at Worthy Down.
