

Driver Vehicle Support Specialist (VSS) – The Royal Logistic Corps Record of Achievement (RoA) Class 3 – 2 Upgrade

Course Aim.

The aim of the RoA is to ensure that the Driver VSS Class 3 soldier gains experience and is competent in the skills required prior to the award of the RLC trade specific Class 2 CEQ. The RoA is based on tasks taken from the Job Specification (JS) and Role Performance Statement (RPS) to ensure practical experience is gained in the relevant employment areas of operation. This is essential for the all-round development of individual trade training.

Course Objectives.

Training Objectives associated with the Driver VSS RoA Class 3 – 2 Upgrade are:

Driver Class 2 RPS:

- Drive a Military LGV and trailer
- Carry out operator maintenance on a military vehicle and trailer
- Operate under field conditions
- Complete driver documentation
- Position and secure a load on a Military LGV

VSS Class 2 RPS:

- Move A & B Vehicles & Equipment
- Perform temporary storage duties
- Maintain vehicles & equipment
- Prepare vehicles for recovery

Duration.

The upgrade can be achieved no less than 18 months from the original Driver VSS Class 3 qualification date.

Enrolment Criteria.

Personnel must meet the following criteria to begin the upgrade process¹:

- Have attended and passed the RLC VSS Class 3 course
- Hold category H on their licence
- Have passed a minimum of 2 AFV platforms on the RLC VSS A vehicle Light course.

¹ Request to deviate can be sought in accordance with RLC Training Instructions.

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Accreditation.

There is currently no accreditation associated with this course.

Dates & Enrolment.

Once awarded the Driver VSS Class 3 qualification, the upgrade process can begin. This is managed by a designated SPOC within unit lines who will issue the RoA booklet ([RoA Class 3 - 2 Upgrade Booklet](#)) and manage the soldier's progress throughout their development.
