

# **Driver Vehicle Support Specialist (VSS) – The Royal Logistic Corps Class 3 Course**

## **Course Aim.**

To teach RLC Driver VSS's the basic procedures for processing vehicles and their associated equipment's through the Joint Supply Chain (JSC) in order to support operational and peacetime operations as directed by Defence.

## **Course Objectives.**

Training Objectives associated with the VSS Class 3 course are:

- Complete the RLC Driver Class 3 Course. This must be completed prior to attending the VSS Class 3 course.
- Move A, B and C Vehicles and Equipment.
- Perform storage duties for vehicles and Equipment's whilst they are held in a storage location.
- Maintain vehicles and equipment IAW with respective AESP's.
- Prepare Vehicles for recovery.
- Perform the duties of a VSS Class 3 for the receipt and issue process for all Tri-service vehicle and equipment's.
- Complete category H licence acquisition. This can be completed on the RLC VSS Category H Licence Acquisition Course.
- Pass a minimum of 2 AFV platforms on the RLC VSS Light A Vehicle course. This course is delivered by The Armoured Centre in Bovington.

## **Duration.**

The course is 10 days long and is delivered by 73 Sqn, LSTW at SMC Marchwood.

## **Enrolment Criteria.**

Personnel must meet the following criteria to apply for the course<sup>1</sup>:

- Hold the vocational RLC Driver Class 3 qualification.
- Hold a valid UK Driving Licence with category H entitlement.

## **Accreditation.**

There is currently no accreditation associated with this course.

## **Dates & Enrolment.**
