

ME418 AdSling

Course Aim.

To train Army Marine Engineers in the skills to allow you to sling or “Fleet” a load through the ship from one location to another safely

Course Objectives.

Training Objectives associated with the ME418 course are:

Detail the precautions and preparation required for slinging operations

To be able to carry out Load Calculations

To be able to Identify various items of lifting equipment their uses and limitations

Adhere to safe systems of work

Duration.

The course is 2 weeks residential training delivered by DSMarE HMS Sultan.

Enrolment Criteria.

Personnel must meet the following criteria to apply for the course¹:

- Be a Class 3 Marine Engineer
- Recommended by their parent unit to attend

Accreditation.

There are no formal qualifications for this course.
