

# Communications Specialist – The Royal Logistic Corps Class 3 Course

## CSS Communications Specialist Class 3 BCiP 5.6

### Course Aim.

To train Combat Service Support (CSS) personnel to be competent in the CSS Communications Specialist Class 3 BCiP 5.6 role.

### Course Objectives.

Training Objectives associated with the Class 3 course are:

- TO1 Use voice Procedure on Combat Net Radio.
- TO2 Implement Electronic Warfare (EW) Measures.
- TO3 Operate Field Telephone Equipment.
- TO4 Setup a Command Post Environment.
- TO5 Acknowledge Cryptographic Procedures.
- TO6 Employ AE for Communications.
- TO7 Operate BKVMS Equipment.
- TO8 Erect/Assemble In-Service Masts and Antenna.
- TO9 Conduct the duties of a PRR User IAW C.4 Learning SCALAR.
- TO10 Conduct the duties of a Complex Platform User (CPU) IAW C.4 Learning SCALAR.
- TO11 Communicate in a CBRN Environment.

### Duration.

The course is four weeks residential training delivered by CIS Sqn at DST Leconfield.

### Enrolment Criteria.

Personnel must meet the following criteria to apply for the course<sup>1</sup>:

- Entitled Personnel - **RLC, REME, RAMC, INT CORPS** and **AGC (RMP)**.
- Be selected as suitable for training as a Comms Spec Class 3.
- Hold a minimum vetting status of BPSS.
- Medical Grade MFD (MLD/MND in special circumstances).
- Registered and activated Defence Learning Environment (DLE) account.
- Pregnant personnel are not to attend this course.

### Qualifications Gained

- BOWMAN Personal Role Radio User.
- BOWMAN Complex Platform Use (CPU) BCiP 5.6.
- RLC Communications Specialist Class 3.

### Accreditation.

The course is accredited and mapped to professional qualifications at Level 3.
